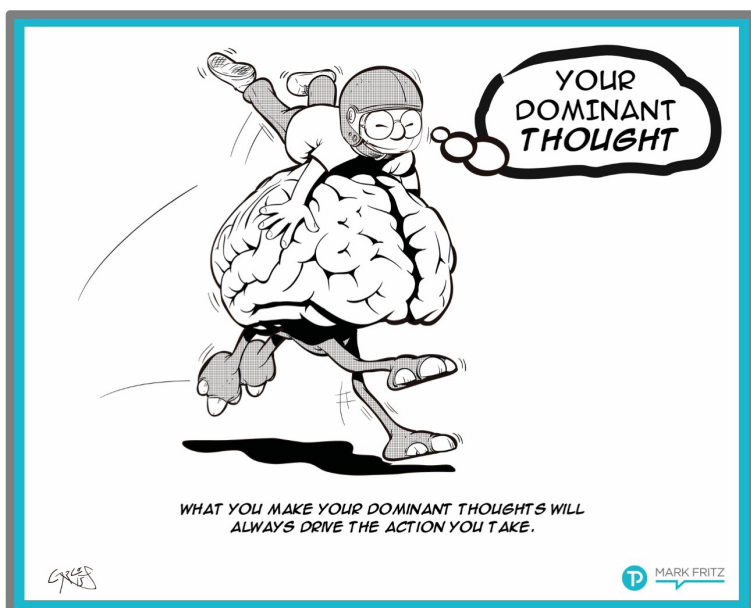


Core Leadership Reminders - 1

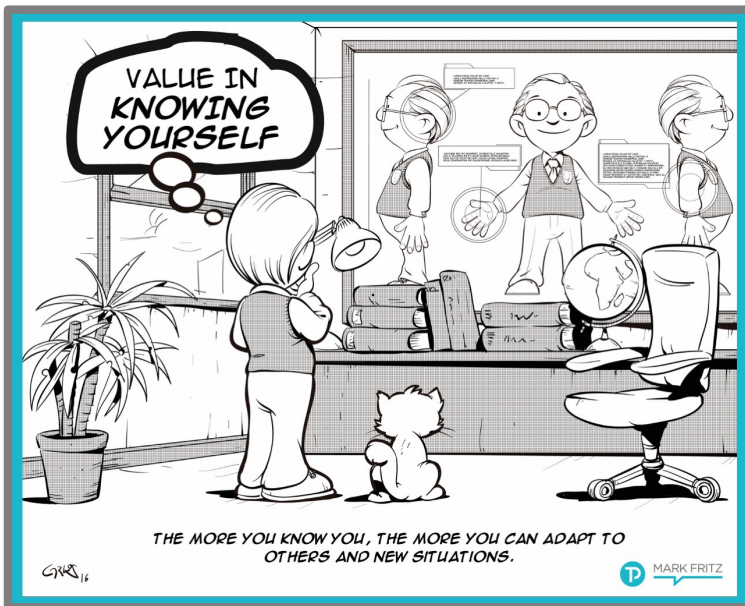

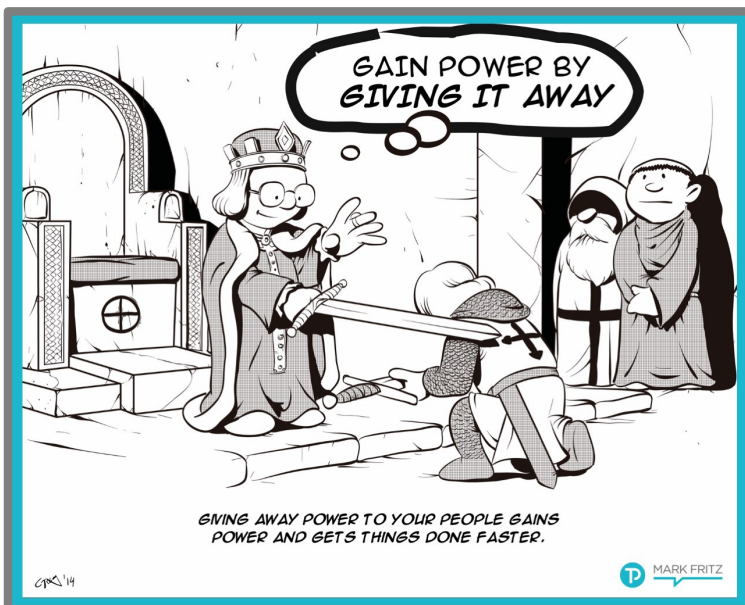

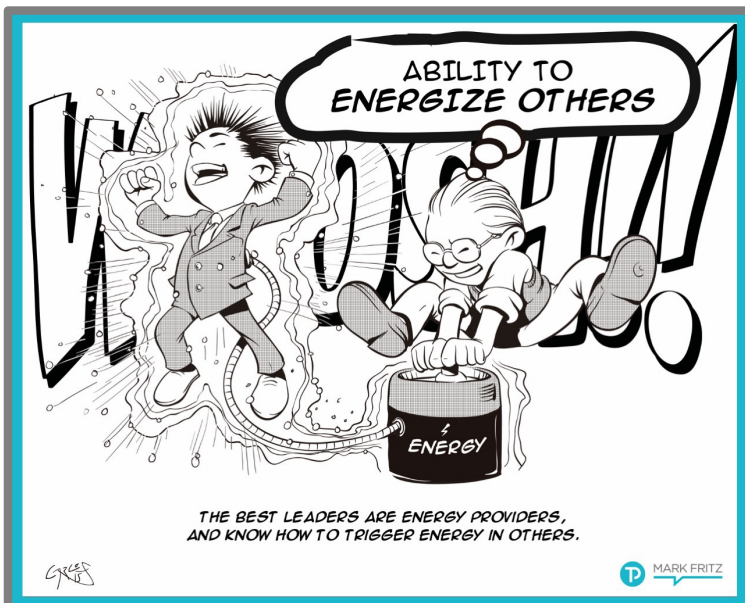
Core Leadership Reminders - 2

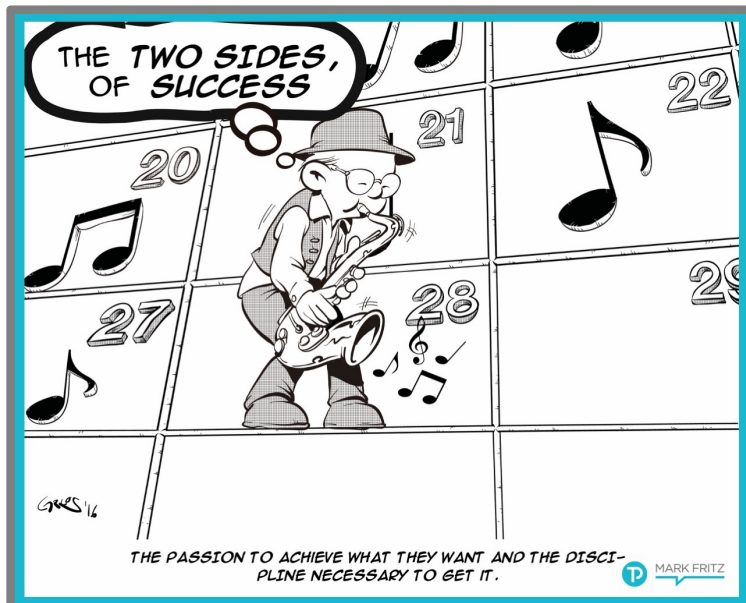

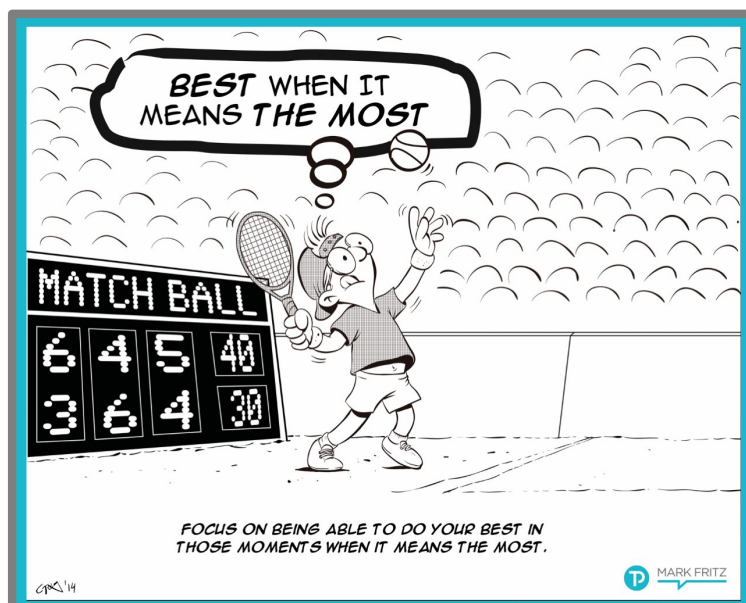
Core Leadership Reminders - 3



When you are **consistent** in our behaviors, you influence positively before you show up. When you are not, you put question marks about you in others, with them often skeptical of what you say.



Simple **disciplines** added to your day/week enable you to be the leader you need to be...gaining more influence and achieving more sustained success. Also, it takes discipline and a **little structure** in order to make the most impact with your passion.



You perform better in the moment when you are prepared for it. Doing your **preparation** (especially with your key questions) helps you to have stronger influence in the moments when it really counts.

Core Leadership Reminders - 4



Your leadership success and power comes from getting your people to **feel it's theirs**. You achieve more success by making **your people stars** than being a star.



You can't use the full power of your team unless you **get everyone engaged**. Create an environment which encourages everyone to speak up, share their ideas, and even disagree with each other at times.
